

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

between

**Griffith University
Queensland, Australia**

and the

**Collège communautaire du Nouveau-Brunswick,
Canada**

This Memorandum of Understanding constitutes an agreement between Griffith University (GU) and the Collège communautaire du Nouveau-Brunswick (CCNB).

Objective of the Agreement

Griffith University agrees to facilitate the block transfer of students from the Collège communautaire du Nouveau-Brunswick (CCNB) with appropriate prerequisite qualifications and grades into the related Griffith degree. By this agreement, applicants from CCNB who meet the requirements outlined below will be eligible for admission to GU with full block transfer credit provided all other entrance criteria, including a cumulative average of 65%+, are met and space remains available in the related program of study. Entrance to all GU programs is on a competitive basis.

- GU will grant 2 years of advanced standing (i.e., entry into the fifth semester) of a related GU undergraduate Bachelor degree (normally of three years duration) on completion of a CCNB Diploma.
- GU will accept for entry into related Masters programs, providing all entry criteria are satisfied and places are available, students who have successfully completed a College undergraduate Degree or Applied Degree.

Programs Defined by this Agreement

The successful completion of the CCNB programs listed in the attached schedules is included in this agreement.

Conditions and Agreed Responsibilities

As party to this Agreement, CCNB agrees to:

- Make information about this agreement and the GU programs options available to students enrolled in related CCNB programs; and,
- Provide opportunity for GU representatives to visit appropriate forums at CCNB to disseminate information about the GU programs.

As party to this agreement, GU agrees to:

- Accept students who meet the criteria identified above from CCNB providing all conditions as outlined in this agreement are met;
- Provide CCNB with updated information about the GU programs;
- Notify CCNB with as much lead time as possible, of any program changes or requirements.

Liaison

Both parties agree to appoint and identify a key authority or individual responsible for liaison and implementation of this agreement.

Review

Both institutions will be responsible for a regular review of the program. This review may make appropriate and mutually agreed modifications as required and identify new opportunities for co-operation.

Terms of the Agreement


This Memorandum of Understanding will be effective when both parties have signed it and shall remain in force unless terminated by either party giving the other party six (6) months written notice.

Griffith University retains the right to limit the number of students admitted under this agreement.

This Agreement may be amended or modified at any time by the mutual consent of the cooperating institutions. The termination of this Agreement shall allow for any participating students who have commenced at either institution at the date of termination to complete their approved course of study.


